

Classroom Rentals

The Menomonie Market Food Co-op Classroom is a beautiful, sunny space located on our second level. It is available for rent to community members, businesses, private groups, and more. Reservation is required.

Who can rent the classroom?

Community groups and organizations needing a space to meet are welcome to use the classroom. Seating capacity with tables is approximately 25, without tables up to 40. The room may not be rented for commercial use, promotion of a business that competes with MMFC products, or fee-based events (unless sponsored by MMFC). Outside food is not permitted; however MMFC offers a variety of catering options from simple coffee service, to served meals. Please contact us for more information about catering!

Availability

Priority of classroom use is given to Menomonie Market's educational program. For this reason, we cannot guarantee this space for repeating monthly meetings, or long term rentals. The classroom is available weekdays 7:30am-8:30pm and weekends 8:30am-7:30 pm.

Cost

Full Day \$100, Half Day \$60, or \$25 per hour

Non-Profits: 1-3 hours FREE, \$15 per hour past 3.

Full day rentals require a deposit of \$50 toward rental fee to hold the space.

Reservation

To request a reservation, please complete the classroom rental request online at mmfc.coop/classroom or pick up a copy at the customer service desk. Please allow up to 5 days for us to process your request and get back to you. If the date is available we will ask that you fill out a Classroom Rental Agreement Form and return it to MMFC with full payment before we can reserve the classroom for your date and time. Forms must be submitted at least 7 days prior to the date of the event.
